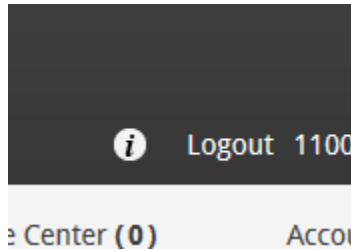


## Using the 3M Cloud Library

The MAIN libraries are please to present the 3M Cloud library which will be replacing over drive as our E-book and E-audiobook vendor. You need your library card and your pin number (your pin number is the last 4 digits of the phone number you gave the library when you got your card) to checkout books. You are allowed to check out 3 items at a time and to have up to 5 on hold at a time. Loan periods are 14 days. **The 3M Cloud Library is not compatible with Kindle Readers; only Kindle Fires will work via the App.**

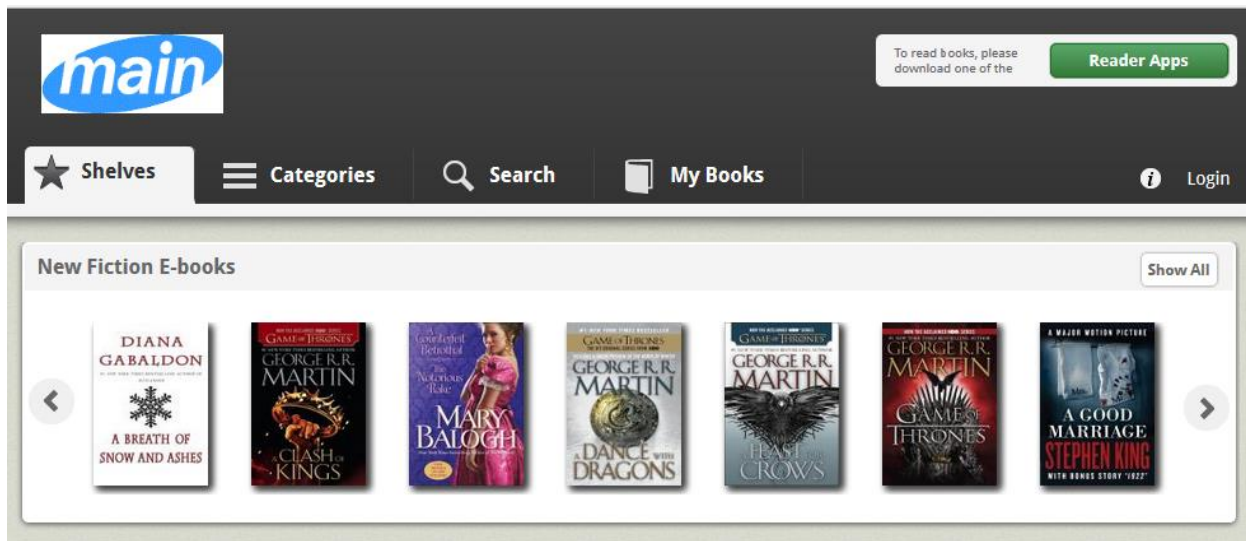

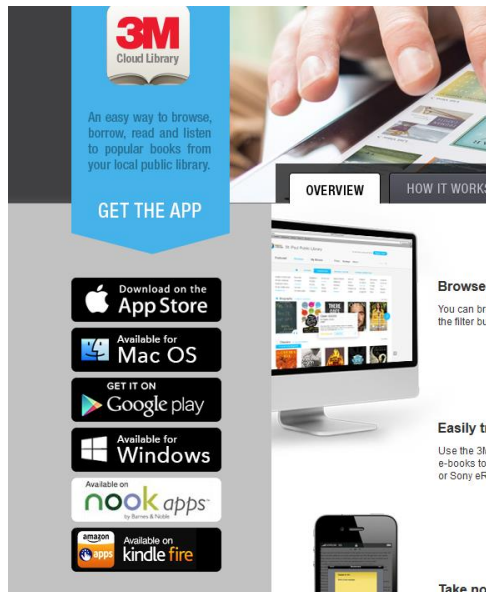

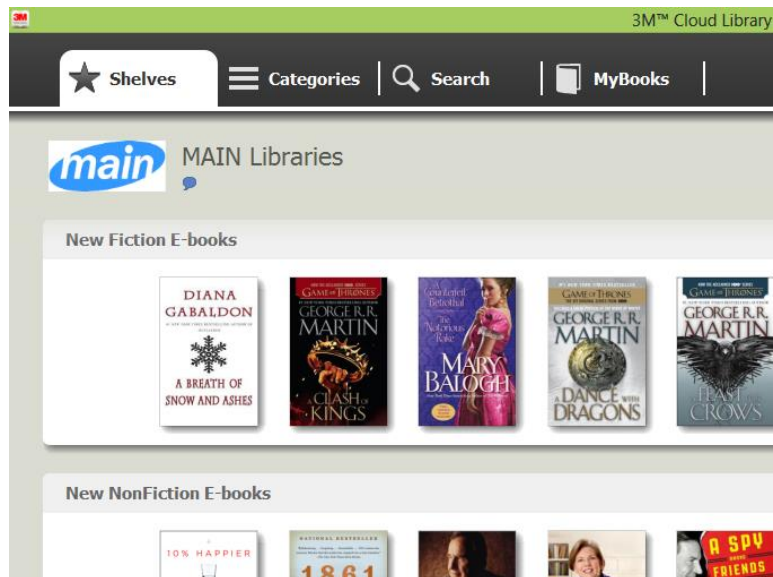
The following configuration provides the optimal experience while using the PC application.

- **Internet Connection:** Broadband (minimum 1.5 Mbps)

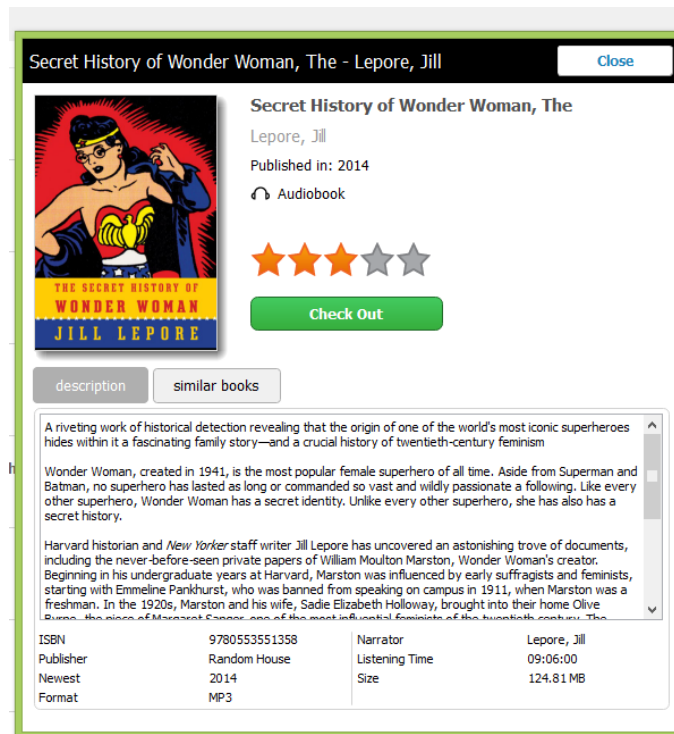
**DOWNLOAD APP**

Click [Download App](#) and follow the instructions to download the device.

The 3M app is now on your desktop. From the [Desktop App](#) you can checkout books, read books, and listen to your books on the desktop. The desktop app will also be what you use to transfer your books to your e-reader device.



From here you can search for an item, click on the item and then click *Check Out*.




The Item will go to your *My Books* tab. To use the item click on it.

E-audiobooks will open up a web-page to listen to the book, and e-books will open in your e-book tab.

## Step 2: Placing Holds

If an item you want is already checked out, you can put a hold on it.

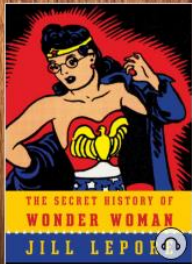

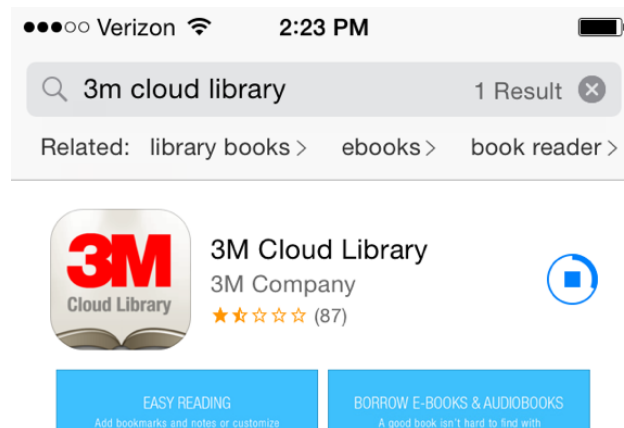
To return books early. Click on the *MyBooks* tab and click *list view* then *Return item*.

To change your e-mail address, you can click on *account settings* on the website and in the app.

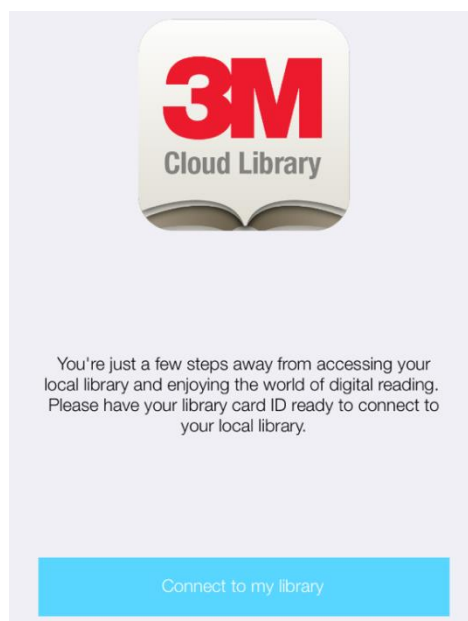
To transfer to your nook or other e-reader device, plug your device into your PC and open the *3M desktop app*. A green button will appear next to your checked out items that says *download to device*. Click on the button and the item will transfer to your device.

### Step 3: Mobile Devices

From the store where you get your apps, search for *3M cloud library*. Download the app.



From the app, click *connect to my library*.




Then select United States, New Jersey, and MAIN Libraries.

Enter your library card number and your PIN number, then agree to the terms and conditions.

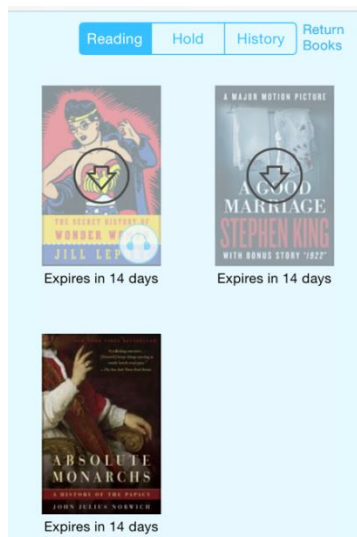
