

Ebook and Eaudio instructions

One click digital e-books can be enjoyed on your desktop or on your mobile device, but first time users must create an account on the webpage before they can sign on using the mobile app. Unfortunatly this software is not compatible with regular Kindle Readers, but only the Kindle Fire through the App.


Step 1: Go to the website

Go to the one click digital website by clicking on the link at www.montvillelibrary.com or by going to http://montvillenj.oneclickdigital.com/Home/Featured.aspx In the top right hand corner click Creat New Account.



Step 2: Create an Account

Fill out the information required and select a username and password that you will use to log on to the site.




Please note that you must first create an account on the website before you can sign in to the mobile app.

Step 3: Download software for use on desktop/mobile apps

To read books on your desktop you must download Adobe Digital Editions from the link on the page.

To use adobe digital editions you must have an adobe ID, which you can sign up for, for free, on www.adobe.com.

To use e-Audio you must download the e-Audio desktop app from the page by clicking on the applicable link.



The mobile apps are available by searching for *one click digital* in your device's app store.

Step 4 Online Support is available






Step 5: Checking out items on desktop



Simply click on the item you want and if it is available click checkout now.


Then you will be given the prompt to open the item with the software you downloaded. Click *ok* and begin to enjoy.



Items downloaded on your desktop can be transferred to your digital device.

If an item is unavailable you can place it on hold using your e-mail address. You will be contacted via e-mail when the item becomes available.

Under the My Collections tab, you can see your holds and your checked out items.



Step 6: Returning Items/Loan Policy

You can check out up to two items at once and the checkout period is 14 days. If there are no holds you can renew the item once. When you are finished with your item you can return it early. After the load period expires, the item will be returned automatically.

To return an item early simply follow the instructions in the website or in the app by the item you wish to return.

Step 7: Using the Apps

The OneClickdigital app is used much like the website. You log in using the username and password you created and you can check out and enjoy your items in the app.


There are however TWO free apps to download to enjoy your content: the *OneClickdigital eaudio* app and the *OneClickdigital eReader* app. One is for eAudiobooks one is for eBooks.

Step 8 e-Audio App (Audiobooks Only)

From the App store on your device search for **OneClickdigital eAudio** and download. The first time you click on the eAudio app you will be asked to use the username and password that you created your account with from the website.



The first time you use the app you will be offered a tutorial which will walk you through using the app.




After that you can read, listen, return, and check out items using the mobile app.


Step 9 eReader App (eBooks Only)

The first time you open the eReader app, you will be asked to log in using an adobe ID. If you use the Overdrive app, it is the same adobe ID you used, if not you will have to click *Create a free adobe ID* and follow the steps to create an Adobe ID and Password.



Once you authorize the device you must select the region, so click on *United States/Canada* and then you will sign in using the username and password you created on the website.





After that simply click on *Get books* to browse and check out books, click *library* to see the books you have checked out and downloaded and to choose a book to read.
